Boarding Policies

- All clients are required to READ our boarding polices and SIGN the boarding contract.
- Dogs must have current immunizations against Rabies, Distemper, Parvovirus, and Bordetella, and Bronchitis. Cats must have current immunizations against Rabies, Feline Distemper, and Rhinotracheitis.
- All animals must have had a fecal examination for intestinal parasites within the past 12 months.
- Dogs must have had a heartworm blood test within the past 12 months.
- All animals must be free of external parasites (fleas & ticks) when admitted for boarding; or will be treated upon admission.
- Animals will be admitted & discharged **ONLY** during regular office hours.
- All boarders will receive a boarder assessment by a licensed veterinary technician at the time of check in. While there is no fee for this assessment, if the LVT determines that your pet has a condition which requires a doctor's attention or treatment, the client will be charged for those treatments.
- Please be aware that your pet may develop diarrhea due to the stress of being in an unfamiliar environment or from eating a different food. They also may have barked more than usual or the temperature & humidity may have been different than at home. This can create problems such as sore throat or tonsillitis.
- Any animal that requires emergency or immediate veterinary attention will receive it at our discretion and the owner will be responsible for all charges.
- An emergency telephone number where the owner or owner's agent can be reached immediately must be left with the clinic at check in.
- Exotic pets must be brought in a properly ventilated and sized enclosure. Clients are to bring all food and bedding required for the duration their exotic pets stay.
- We will provide:
- clean, fresh bedding daily.
- fresh water
- 3 exercise periods per day
- Dry EN food unless otherwise requested (It is recommended that you bring your pet's regular food with you to avoid dietary disturbances during boarding).
- o Animals requiring medication or treatment(s) will be a charged daily administration fee.
- Boarding patients may be dropped off or picked up ONLY DURING OUR REGULARLY SCHEDULED OFFICE HOURS which are: Monday – Thursday 8am to 6pm, Friday 8am to 5pm and Saturday 8am to 12 Noon. These hours are subject to change without notice due to weather conditions and holiday schedules.
- Our boarding fees are charged as follows:
 - o 8am to 5pm –FULL DAY
 - o **8am to 12 NOON HALF DAY**Patients checking out after 12 Noon, will be charged for a full days boarding.
